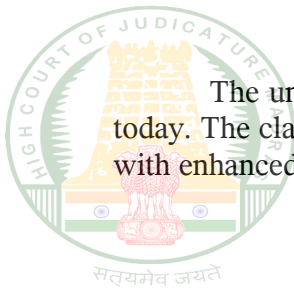

This case came up for settlement before the Lok Adalat. Both the parties present. The counsel for the appellant/s A.Elis Chitra Devi and the counsel for the respondent/s C.Murugavel are present. After mutual discussion, negotiation, mediation and conciliation between both parties and with the assistance of the Bench, both sides consented for settlement.

AWARD

Aggrieved by the order passed in M.C.O.P.No.31 of 2019 on the file of Principal Sub-Court, Nagercoil, the claimant preferred this appeal against the award of Rs.3,67,000/-.

Today, the appellant as well as the Insurance Company represented that after mutual discussion, taking into consideration the age of the mother of the appellant and various other factors. the parties have decided to settle the claim at Rs.2,00,000/- over and above the award amount in full quits. The tribunal has already directed the insurance company to pay the amount and recover it from the owner of the vehicle. We have not disturbing the finding of the tribunal.



The unborrowed award amount Rs.2,00,000/- is to deposited within a period of eight today. The claimant/appellant is entitled to withdraw the compensation amount already deposited together with enhanced compensation, without insisting any formal payment out petition.

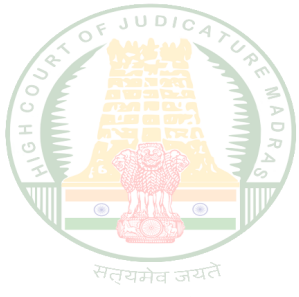
The Original of the award shall be place in the court record and copy of the award, kept with High Court Legal Services Committee and one copy each is furnished to both parties free of cost.
