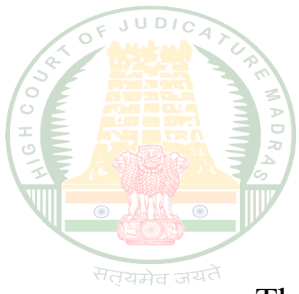

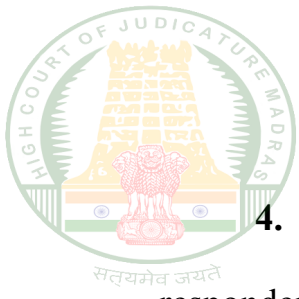

ORDER

This petition has been filed seeking to call for the records and strike off the impugned proceedings in D.V.C.No.6 of 2025 on the file of the learned Judicial Magistrate, Rameshwaram so far as the petitioners are concerned.

2. The petitioners herein are the respondents 2 to 8 in D.V.C.No.6 of 2025, before the trial Court. The respondents 1 & 2 herein have filed D.V.C.No.6 of 2025, before the Judicial Magistrate, Rameshwaram, under the provisions of the Domestic Violence Act and BNSS, 2023.

3. The learned counsel appearing for the petitioners submit that they are the in-laws of the first respondent. The first respondent has initiated domestic violence proceedings against the petitioners and her husband. It is submitted that the petitioners are in no way connected with the allegations made by the first respondent in the DVC case and though third respondent is ready and willing to live with the first respondent it is only the 1st respondent who is not coming to live with him and has initiated the present case. Therefore, he prays that the petitioners may be permitted to raise all the grounds mentioned herein before the trial court. He also requests this Court to dispense with their personal appearance before the trial court.

4. Since no adverse order is going to be passed as against the respondents, notice to the respondents is dispensed with.

5. This Court, taking into consideration the submission made by the learned counsel for the petitioners, permit the petitioners to raise all the grounds as raised herein before the trial court at the time of trial. Taking into consideration the request made by the learned counsel for the petitioners, their appearance before the trial court is dispensed with except for their appearance for the purpose of receiving the copy of the proceedings u/s 230 of BNSS, framing of charges, questioning under Section 351 of BNSS and on the day on which judgment is to be pronounced. However, if for any particular reason, the presence of the petitioners is necessary, the trial court, at its wisdom, shall direct them to appear on those days.

6. Accordingly, this Civil Revision Petition stands disposed of. There shall be no order as to costs. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petitions are closed.
