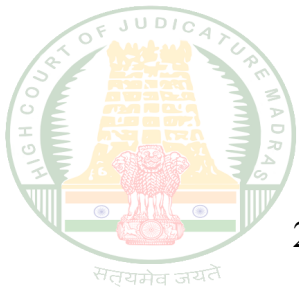

ORDER

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2. When the matter is taken up for hearing, the learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondent police submits that the petitioner has not lodged any complaint before the respondent police and he has also not enclosed any acknowledgement for having lodged such complaint.

3. Since the petitioner is not having any acknowledgement and the respondent police has also denied that they have not received any complaint, this Writ Petition is closed with liberty to the petitioner to lodge a fresh complaint to the respondent police through registered post. On receipt of complaint, the respondent police shall consider the same in accordance with law.
