3.The learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondent police submits that the proposed place is traffic prone area and it also falls on a working day. Therefore, considering all these, they have not granted permission that it may cause inconvenience to the public and may also lead to law and order issue.



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4.This court considered the rival submissions made.

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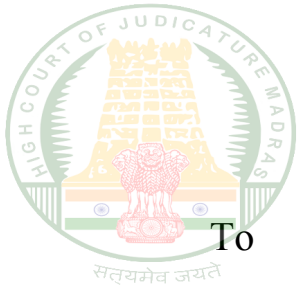
