The learned Counsel appearing for the petitioner would submit that there is a typographical error occurred in the said Criminal Original Petition, it is inadvertently stated the satisfaction Court as learned Judicial Magistrate No.IV, Madurai instead of the learned Judicial Magistrate No.I, Madurai. Hence, he prays to allow the present amendment petition. Further, the learned counsel for the petitioner prays to extend the time period to comply the condition imposed against the petitioner in CrI.O.P.(MD)No.10320 of 2025 dated 30.06.2025.

3. Considering the submissions made by the learned counsel for the Petitioner and being satisfied with the reasons stated above, this Court is inclined to allow these Criminal Miscellaneous Petitions.
