PRAYER: Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying this Court to issue a Writ of Mandamus, directing the respondent to revise/re-fix the scale of pay of the petitioner w.e.f. 01.09.19 to till his retirement, based on the wage settlement dated 24.08.22 and consequently to pay him difference of terminal benefits, namely Gratuity and Encashment of Leave, after revising the same based on such re-fixed scale of pay payable to him on the month of his retirement, together with 18% interest per annum, within a time frame as may be fixed by this Court.

ORDER

The present Writ Petition has been filed by a retired “Driving Instructor” of the respondent Transport Corporation seeking a Mandamus to disburse the difference of wages arising out of 14th wage settlement, dated 24.08.2022.

2. According to the learned counsel appearing for the writ petitioner, the petitioner had attained superannuation on 31.01.2020 and the 14th wage settlement was entered into on 24.08.2022 with retrospective effect from 01.09.2019. The petitioner has sent a representation to the respondent on 02.06.2025 seeking arrears of terminal benefits. Since there is no response, the present writ petition has been filed.

3. Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned Standing Counsel appearing for the respondent.



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4. Considering the above said facts, the respondent herein is directed to release the eligible benefits upon the writ petitioner along with interest at the rate of 6% p.a., from the due date till the date of disbursement, within a period of twelve weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

5. With the above said observations, this Writ Petition stands disposed of. There shall be no order as to costs.
