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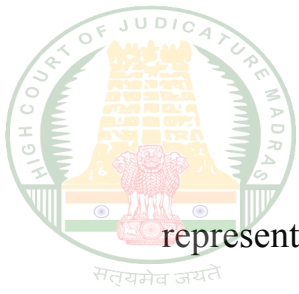

The learned Additional Government Pleader for the respondents 2 and 3 submits that the petitioner's representation/application dated 13.05.2024 and reminder dated 25.06.2025 to take over the temple by the Hindu Religious and Charitable Endowments Department, namely Shree Angalaparameswari Amman Temple, Kadamburar Street, Mela Ulur, Orathanadu Taluk, Thanjavur District, will be considered and disposed of on merits within a period of three months.
