PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.482 of BNSS

PRAYER :-

For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.22 of 2025 on the file of the Respondent Police.



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ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioner, who apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 120(b), 420, 423, 463 and 464 of IPC,1860 in Crime No.22 of 2025 on the file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that the defacto complainant purchased the land from the 1st accused. The 1st accused get the amount from the defacto complainant but the 1st accused has not executed the sale deed in favour of the defacto complainant. Hence, a case has been registered.

3.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case and he has not committed any offence. He seeks this Court to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

4.The learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side) strongly opposed to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

5.This Court has already dismissed the bail applications and the anticipatory bail applications of the co-accused. In spite of granting interim



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anticipatory bail to the petitioner, this Court is not inclined to extend the same and the same is vacated.

6. Taking into consideration the facts and circumstances of the case, the nature and gravity of the offence and the specific overt act against the petitioner, this Court is not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner at this stage.

7. Accordingly, this Criminal Original Petition is dismissed.
