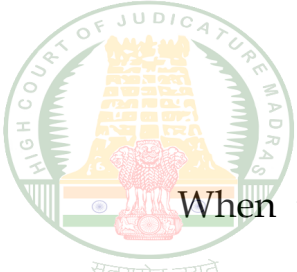
Prayer in WMP(MD). No.17922 of 2024 :-
