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ORDER

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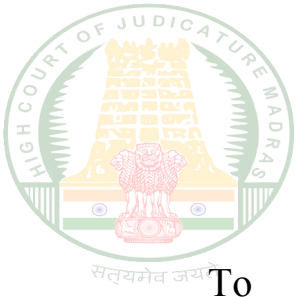
The petitioner with a grievance that his complaint has not been enquired by the respondent police has filed this petition.
