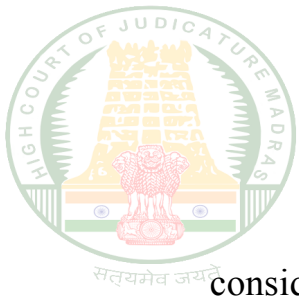

ORDER

This writ petition is filed for *Writ of Mandamus* directing the Respondents to repair the cart track leading to Kovilangulam Village by considering the representation given by the Petitioner dated 05.08.2024.

2. The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that the respondents are removing gravel from a nearby pond, which can be used to level the track. Instead of utilizing the same, the respondents have removed it for some other use.

3. The learned Special Government Pleader appearing for the respondents submitted that the Block Development Officer, Aruppukottai Taluk, Virudhunagar District, is the appropriate authority to

consider this issue. In view of the aforesaid submission, this Court has *suo motu* impleaded the Block Development Officer as the 4th respondent.
