Prayer in WMP(MD). No.17978 of 2024:-

Writ Miscellaneous Petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, to extend the time limit for the further period of six months in respect of the direction issued to respondents to keep the proceedings in abeyance in WP(MD) 6377/2023 dated 05.04.2023.

Prayer in WP(MD)No.6377 of 2023:-

Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying to issue a Writ of Certiorarified Mandamus, to call for the records pertaining to the impugned order in Na.Ka.No.7699/2021/NGA-1 dated 21.02.2023 on the file of the first respondent and the consequential impugned order in Na.Ka.No.75/2021/date/23.2.23 dated 27.02.2023 on the file of the second respondent and quash the same as illegal and consequently for a direction, directing



the respondents to keep the disciplinary proceedings initiated against the petitioner in pursuance to the charge memo dated 08.07.2022 in abeyance till the disposal of the Criminal Case in Crime No. 838/2021 on the file of the Sub-Inspector of Police, Nilakottai Police Station, Dindigul District within the time period stipulated by this Court.
