ORDER

This Criminal Original Petition has been filed seeking to quash the final report in C.C.No.1255 of 2024, on the file of the learned Judicial Magistrate No.V, Madurai, filed against the petitioners for the offences punishable under Sections 294(b), 323, 324, 506(1) and 109 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860.

2. The allegation in the final report is that, due to a matrimonial dispute between the first petitioner and the son of the second respondent/defacto complainant, the first and second petitioners, at the instigation of the third and fourth petitioners, came to the house of the second respondent/defacto complainant, abused the second respondent/defacto complainant and her husband, and attacked them with bricks and hands, and thus committed the aforesaid offences.

3. Admittedly, the petitioners and the second respondent/defacto complainant are relatives, and there was a matrimonial dispute between



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the first petitioner and the son of the second respondent/defacto complainant. The parties have now entered into a compromise and decided to give a quietus to the entire dispute. The parties have filed a joint compromise memo dated 07th October, 2025. The scanned copy of the compromise memo reads as follows:

JOINT COMPROMISE MEMO

It is submitted that Petitioners and the 2nd Respondent are hereby enter into a compromise and agree on the following terms.

1. It is submitted that the Petitioner prefer the Criminal Original Petition praying before this Hon'ble Court to quash the Charge Sheet in CC No: 1255 of 2024, on the file of Judicial Magistrate -V, Madurai.
2. It is submitted that the Petitioners/Accused No.1 to 4 with the defacto complainant filed the above joint compromise memo in the quash petition. The Petitioners and the Respondent No-2/defacto complainant settled their disputes through compromise.
3. It is submitted that the allegation of the prosecution case is that the Defacto Complainant namely Panchavarnam, wife of Ariyamuthu alleged in her complaint that on 11.03.2023, the Petitioners assaulted the defacto complainant and threatened with dire consequences. Based on that the defacto complainant complaint the Respondent police has registered the case F.I.R. in Crime No. 13 of 2023. Thereafter, the Charge Sheet also filed in CC No: 1255 of 2024, on the file of Judicial Magistrate-V, Madurai and the same was pending. Now the defacto complainant as well as the petitioner has settled their dispute among the elders and family friends.

It is submitted that based on that complaint the First Information Report (F.I.R.) has been registered for the alleged offences Under Sections 294(b), 323, 324, 506(1) and 109 of IPC in Crime No: 13 of 2023 dated 11.03.2023 on the file of the 1st Respondent Police station. It is submitted that after completed the investigation, the 1st Respondent filed the Charge sheet in CC No: 1255 of 2024, on the file of Judicial Magistrate-V, Madurai and the same was pending.
 5. It is submitted that the petitioners and the Defacto complainant compromised the issue. The defacto complainant does not want to prosecute further against the petitioners. It is further submitted that since the dispute between the parties has been settled on by way of compromise. The Defacto complainant has no objection in quashing of the Charge sheet in CC No: 1255 of 2024, on the file of Judicial Magistrate-V, Madurai. Moreover the Defacto complainant does not want to pursue the proceedings against the petitioners. Otherwise also, no purpose would be served in case, the proceedings are continued in future as the complainant is not going to depose against the petitioner. Therefore in view of settlement the continuation of impugned criminal proceedings between the parties would be an exercise in futility and it will be wastage of precious time of the Court.

Therefore it is most respectfully prayed that this Hon'ble Court may be pleased to record this Joint Compromise Memo as part and parcel of the order and thus render justice.

4. The petitioners, namely, (1) Nandhini [Aadhaar No.5776 6024 2926], (2) Sathyabama [Aadhaar No.5565 7350 4919], (3) Madasamy [Aadhaar No.5345 2411 2258] and (4) Dhandapandi @ Samy [Aadhaar No.7271 0255 0254] and the second respondent/defacto complainant, namely, Panchavarnam [Aadhaar No.7510 1471 6589] and the second respondent/defacto complainant's husband/victim are present before this Court in person. The parties are identified by Mr.M.Kannan, Sub-Inspector of Police, Oomachikulam Police Station, Madurai District. All the parties confirmed the compromise arrived at between them. The second respondent/defacto complainant stated that she does not wish to pursue the case against the petitioners.



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5. In view of the same and considering the nature of the offences and the relationship between the parties, this Court is of the view that no useful purpose would be served by keeping the impugned final report pending trial. Accordingly, the impugned final report in C.C.No.1255 of 2024, on the file of the learned Judicial Magistrate No.V, Madurai, is quashed. The petitioners shall pay a sum of Rs.5,000/- as costs to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre attached to the Madurai Bench of Madras High Court forthwith and file a photocopy of the receipt along with a memo reporting compliance in the Registry.

6. Hence, this Criminal Original Petition stands allowed.
