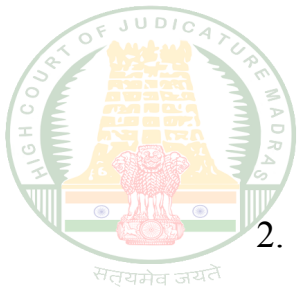

Mr.D.Ghandiraj, learned Special Government Pleader takes notice for the respondent.



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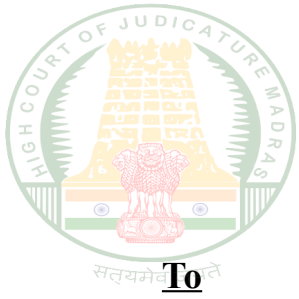
2. This writ petition has been filed for a Mandamus to direct the respondent to expedite the disposal of the petitioner's petition dated 01.04.2025.
