PRAYER: Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying to issue a Writ of Mandamus, to direct the respondents 2 and 3 to depute a surveyor to measure and fix boundaries of petitioner's properties situated in Survey No.261/4B extent about 0.24.0 Ares (60 cents) and Survey No.261/5D extent about 0.30.5 (76 cents) totally 1 Acre 36 cents in Musuvanoothu Village, Nilakottai Taluk, Dindigul District based on the petitioner's application number 2025/0123/13/012207 dated 14.05.2025 within stipulated time fixed by this Court.

ORDER

This Writ Petition is filed seeking a direction to the respondents 2 and 3 to survey the property of the petitioner situated in Survey Nos. 261/4B and 261/5D, in Musuvanoothu Village, Nilakottai Taluk, Dindigul District, by considering the petitioner's application No. 2025/0123/13/012207, dated 14.05.2025.

2. Heard the arguments of Mr.S.Madhankumar, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr.D.S.Nedunchezian, learned Government Advocate, who takes notice for the respondents. By consent, this Writ Petition is taken up for final disposal at the admission stage itself.

3. According to the petitioner, the subject property was settled by petitioner's husband under a settlement deed dated 29.10.2009 and patta for the subject property stands in the name of the petitioner in patta No. 1392. She submitted an application dated 14.05.2025 in application No.



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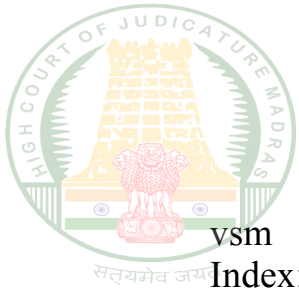
2025/0123/13/012207, seeking survey of the subject property and the same has not been considered. Hence, the petitioner has come before this Court.

4. The learned Government Advocate appearing for the respondents would submit that the application of the petitioner will be considered in accordance with law.

5. In view of the same, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the matter, the respondents 2 and 3 are directed to consider the application of the petitioner dated 14.05.2025 in application No. 2025/0123/13/012207 and pass final orders on its own merits, within a period of eight (8) weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, after issuing notice to the petitioner, neighbouring land owners and other interested parties.

6. With the above direction, this Writ Petition is disposed of. There shall be no order as to costs.
