ORDER

2.Heard the arguments of Mr.R.Jegadeeswaran, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and Mr.M.Gangatharan, learned Government Advocate appearing for the respondents 1 to 3 and Since no adverse order is passed against the fourth respondent, notice to the fourth respondent is dispensed with.

3.By consent of both sides, this Writ Petition is taken up for final disposal at the admission stage itself.

4.According to the petitioner, the second respondent herein deleted the name of the petitioner from the revenue records pertains to the property situated in Survey No.596/7, Ponnamaravathi (East) Village, Ponnamaravathi Taluk, Pudukkottai District, based on the application filed by the fourth respondent. Aggrieved by the said order, the
