This case came up for settlement before the Lok Adalat. Both the parties present. The counsel for the appellant/s Mr.M.K.A.Thirumalaiappan and the counsel for the respondent/s Mr.L.Siva are present. After mutual discussion, negotiation, mediation and conciliation between both parties and with the assistance of the Bench, both sides consented for settlement.

AWARD

The Transport Corporation has filed this appeal as against the award passed by the Special Court, Madurai.

2.The value of the claim petition is Rs.50 lakhs. The Tribunal has awarded a sum of Rs.65,72,100/- with interest. Now the parties have agreed for a settlement of Rs.85,00,000/- (Rupees Eighty Five Lakhs only) as full quit. The said amount shall be paid in four monthly equal installments from today, less the amount, if any, already deposited. On such deposit, the claimant is entitled to withdraw the same.
