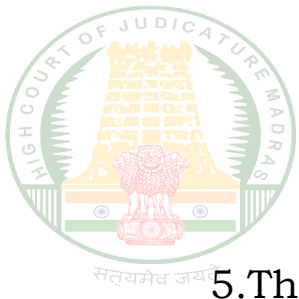

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report.

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4.Recording the above submission, this writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent Police to ensure that the petitioner and his family members are not denied the right of entry in the temple. No costs.

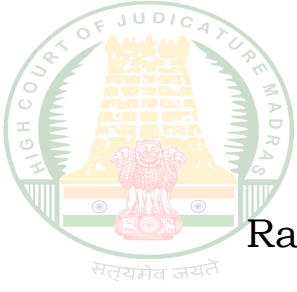
