4.In view of the same, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the matter, the first respondent is directed to consider the proposal submitted by the third respondent in his proceedings in ൩.൧.E2558286/2024/൧3, dated 02.04.2025 and pass final order within a period of twelve weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, after affording reasonable opportunity to the petitioner. Accordingly, this Writ Petition is disposed of. No costs.
