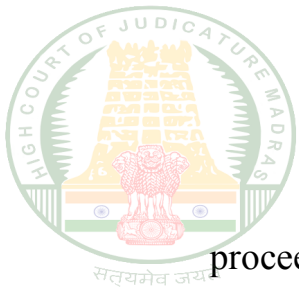

ORDER

The petitioners are accused Nos.1 and 2 in Crime No.48 of 2025 on the file of the respondent Police, which was registered for the offence under Sections 191(2), 191(3), 296(b), 115(2), 118(1), 351(2), 127(2) of BNS and Section 4 of TNPWH Act r/w. Sections 3(1)(r), 3(1)(s), 3(2) (va) of SC/ST (POA) Act, 1989. They have moved this petition seeking to quash the FIR in Crime No.48 of 2025 registered against them.

2. Today, when this petition is taken up for hearing, the learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) submits that the investigation in Crime No.48 of 2025 was completed and the final report has also been filed before the Special Court, Srivilliputhur, through e-filing.

3. Since it is reported that the final report has been filed in Crime No.48 of 2025, without ascertaining the materials relied on by the investigating agency in the final report, this Court is not inclined to



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proceed with the available FIR. Therefore, this Criminal Original Petition is closed with liberty to the petitioners to challenge the final report, if they are having any ground. Mere filing of the final report through e-filing is not sufficient. The respondent Police shall ensure that the final report is taken on file within a reasonable time. It is not only the responsibility of the respondent Police, the trial Court is also expected to take the final report on file, without any delay. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petition is closed.
