PRAYER in WP(MD) No.22776 of 2025: Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of a Writ of Certiorarified Mandamus to call for the records of the 2nd Respondent in his proceedings in Na.Ka.C.V.2/1221-4/2024 dated 06.11.2024 and quash the same as illegal, violation of law and further direct the Respondents to appoint the Petitioner as a Supervisor, with all service benefits within the stipulated time.

PRAYER in WP(MD) No.22777 of 2025: Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of a Writ of Certiorarified Mandamus to call for the records of the 2nd Respondent in his proceedings in Na.Ka.C.V.2/1288/2024 dated 27.11.2024 and quash the same as illegal, violation of law and further direct the Respondents to appoint the Petitioner as a Supervisor, with all service benefits within the stipulated time.

COMMON ORDER

These writ petitions have been filed by the petitioners challenging the suspension orders dated 06.11.2024 and 27.11.2024, passed by the second respondent.

2.Heard the learned counsel for the parties. By consent of both parties, the Writ Petition is taken up for final disposal at the admission stage itself.

3. The petitioners are employed as Salesmen by the respondent Marketing Corporation Limited. Due to alleged misappropriation, they were placed under suspension. Challenging the same, the petitioners have filed these writ petitions.



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4. When the matter was taken up for hearing today, the learned counsel on both sides, submitted that a similarly placed person had earlier filed a writ petition in W.P.(MD) No.22270 of 2025 and this Court, by its order dated 03.06.2025, passed the following order:

“Considering the submissions made on either side, this Court is of the view that the disciplinary proceedings cannot be kept pending indefinitely. Accordingly, the writ petition stands disposed of with the following directions:

(i) The concerned respondent is directed to pay subsistence allowance to the petitioner, if not already paid, strictly in accordance with law; and

(ii) The respondents are directed to conclude the disciplinary proceedings initiated against the petitioner, within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.”

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the issue involved in the present writ petition is squarely covered by the aforesaid order.



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5. In view of the above decision and considering the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, these writ petitions are disposed of with a direction to the concerned respondent to pay subsistence allowance to the petitioner, if not already paid, strictly in accordance with law and further directed to conclude the disciplinary proceedings initiated against the petitioner, within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. There shall be no order as to costs. Consequently, the connected miscellaneous petition is closed.
