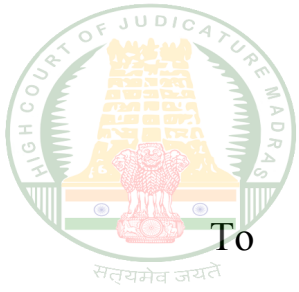
2.The learned Government Advocate (Crl Side) appearing for the respondent submits that they have not received any complaint from the petitioner.
