ORDER

(Order of the Court was made by ***S.M.SUBRAMANIAM, J.***)

This Habeas Corpus Petition has been instituted to direct the respondents 1 and 2 to produce the detainee, namely, Bairavi, D/o. Balaraman, aged about 21 years.

2.The 2nd respondent / Inspector of Police, All Women Police Station, Rajapalayam, Virudhunagar District has produced the detainee before this Court. While examining the detainee, she states that she is aged about 21 years and has completed BCA degree and now, pursuing shorthand course.

3.The 3rd respondent is also present before this Court and would state that he married another woman and his first wife got married with another man and therefore, he married the detainee in the presence of his parents.



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4.The detainee is also willing to live with the 3rd respondent and there is no coercion. Since the detainee is aged about 21 years and completed BCA degree and able to understand what is good and what is bad for her life, this Court is able to form an opinion that the detainee is not under illegal detention. Thus, the detainee is set at free and hence, this Habeas Corpus Petition stands disposed of.
