ORDER

This Criminal Original Petition is filed seeking to quash the FIR in Crime No.187 of 2025 on the file of the first respondent, which was registered for the offences under Section 308(4) and 351(3) of BNS, 2023.

2. The allegation in the FIR is that on 19.06.2025, when the defacto complainant was walking nearby the Morupatti Bus stop, the petitioner waylaid the defacto complainant and snatched Rs.750/- by threatening him with a knife and thus committed the aforesaid offences.

3. Admittedly, the petitioner and the second respondent are residents of the same Village and they have now entered into a compromise and decided to give a quietus to the entire dispute. The parties have filed a joint compromise memo dated 18.08.2025 and the scanned copy of the compromise memo reads as follows:

JOINT COMPROMISE MEMO

1. The Petitioner submits that the 2nd Respondent herein gave complaint against the Petitioner and a case was registered for the alleged offences U/s. 308(4) & 351(3) of BNS, 2023 in Crime No.187/2025 dated 19.06.2025 on the file of the 1st Respondent.

2. The Petitioner submits that the case of the prosecution is that, on 19.06.2025 at about 12.00 Noon, when the Defacto Complainant while walking nearby the Merupatti Bus stop, the Petitioner way laid the Defacto Complainant and threatened with a knife, snatched Rs.750/- and escaped from the scene of occurrence. Hence the case.

3. The Petitioner submits that now the matter has been compromised between the 2nd Respondent and the Petitioner at the intervention of their neighbours, family members, elders and well wishers and the matter has been amicably settled among themselves.

4. The Petitioner submits that he has filed a separate Quash Petition before this Hon'ble Court in connection with

the very same case. The impugned FIR in Crime No.187/2025 dated 19.06.2025 is liable to be quashed.

5. The Petitioner submits that now there is a compromise arrived at between the Petitioner and the 2nd Respondent. In view of the above said compromise, the Petitioner and the 2nd Respondent had submitted this Joint Compromise Memo to quash the criminal proceedings pending in Crime No.187/2025 dated 19.06.2025 on the file of the 1st Respondent Police. The 2nd Respondent have no objection, if this Hon'ble Court may be pleased to quash the said Impugned Criminal proceedings in Crime No.187/2025 on the file of the 1st Respondent Police.

It is therefore prayed that this Hon'ble Court may be pleased to accept this **JOINT COMPROMISE MEMO** and pass such further or other orders, as this Hon'ble Court may deem fit and proper in the circumstances of the case and thus render justice.

4. The petitioner, namely, Perumal (Aadhaar No.9117 0388 8045) and the second respondent/defacto complainant, namely, Vignesh (Aadhaar No.4177 5280 9745) are present before this Court in person. They are identified by Mr.R.Sanjeevi, Special Sub Inspector of Police, Thathaiyangarpettai Police Station, Trichy District. The defacto complainant would state that they belong to the same Village and that in view of the compromise entered between them, the impugned FIR may be quashed.

5. Considering the fact that the petitioner is not a habitual offender and that the parties have now entered into compromise and the dispute being private in nature, this Court is of the view that no useful purpose would be served in keeping the impugned FIR pending investigation. Accordingly, the impugned FIR in Crime No.187 of 2025 dated 19.06.2025 on the file of the first respondent is quashed and the Criminal Original Petition stands allowed.
