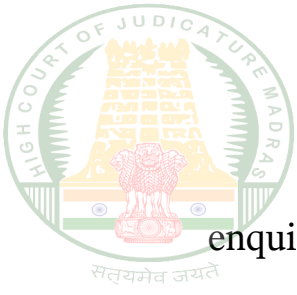

2.The learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondents submits that based on the complaint of the petitioner, an



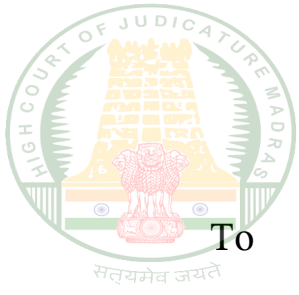
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enquiry has been initiated in CSR.No.1245 of 2025 and they have made request to the first respondent to furnish details about the allegations made by the petitioner.
