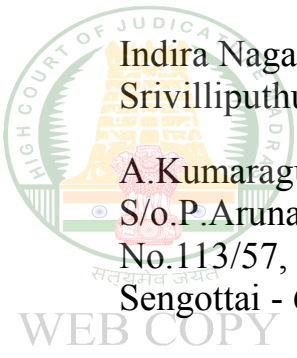

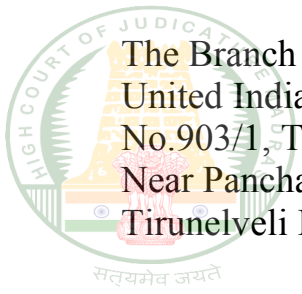

This case came up for settlement before the Lok Adalat. Both the parties present. The counsel for the appellant/s Mr.A.S.Mathialagan and the counsel for the respondent/s Mr.M.Thirunavukkarasu are present. After mutual discussion, negotiation, mediation and conciliation between both parties and with the assistance of the Bench, both sides consented for settlement.

AWARD

Aggrieved by the award passed by the Tribunal, the appellant / Insurance Company has filed the present appeal.

2. After due deliberations, both the parties have entered into compromise and agreed to modify the award amount to a sum of Rs.12,16,000/- (Rupees Twelve Lakhs Sixteen Thousand only) with interest at the rate of 7.5% per annum from the date of petition till the date of realization and costs. The appellant is directed to deposit the said award amount, after deducting the amount already deposited, if any, within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this award. On such deposit being made, the second and third respondents are entitled to a sum of Rs.6,08,000/- each towards their share and they are permitted to withdraw their share together with interest at the rate of 7.5% per annum by filing formal application before the Tribunal.
