PETITION FOR BAIL Under Sec.483 of BNSS

**PRAYER** :- For Bail in Crime No.70 of 2025 on the file of the respondent police.

**ORDER** : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioner, who was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on

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30.03.2025 for the offences punishable under Section 103 altered into Sections 103, 191(2), 191(3), 190, 127(2), 61(2) and 49 of BNS in Crime No.70 of 2025 on the file of the respondent police, seeks bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that on 22.03.2025, at about 8.30 p.m., the defacto complainant's husband left the house stating that he was going to a nearby shop. Thereafter, at about 9.45 p.m., the defacto complainant heard a noise, and when she went near the Paarai Muneeswaran Temple, she found her husband lying dead with cut injuries on his head. On making enquiries, she came to know that some persons had assaulted and murdered her husband. Hence, the complaint.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is an innocent person and he has not committed any offences as alleged by the prosecution. He further submitted that the petitioner is in judicial custody from 30.03.2025. Hence, he seeks bail to the petitioner.

4. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor submitted that there are totally 16 accused and the petitioner is arrayed as A-11. He further submitted that the incident arises out of a gang war involving multiple murders between two groups.



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Therefore, he opposed for grant of bail to the petitioner.

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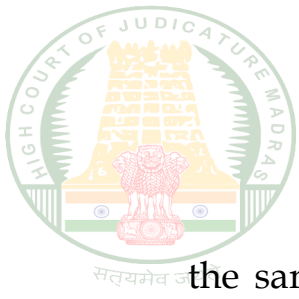
5. Taking into consideration of the facts and circumstances of the case and also considering the period of incarceration suffered by the petitioner, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner, subject to the following conditions:

6. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate, Thirumangalam, Madurai District, and on further conditions that :-

[a] the sureties shall affix their photographs and Left Thumb Impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank pass Book to ensure their identity.

[b] the petitioner shall furnish his residential address and mobile number to the learned Judicial Magistrate, Thirumangalam, Madurai District,

[c] If the petitioner changes his residential address, she shall report



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the same to the learned Judicial Magistrate, Thirumangalam, Madurai District

[d] the petitioner shall stay at Villupuram and appear before the Inspector of police, Villupuram Town Police Station, daily at 10.30 a.m., until further orders. He has to co-operate for the investigation.

[e] the petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial.

[f] the petitioner shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial.

[g] On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560].



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[h] If the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered  
under Section 269 BNS.
