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ORDER

The petitioner with a grievance that though there is a direction from the learned Magistrate, the respondent police has not conducted any enquiry on his complaint and therefore he has filled this application seeking a direction to the respondent police to comply with the order of the learned Magistrate.

Mr.P.Kottaichamy, learned Government Advocate (Crl.side), who takes notice for the respondents 1 & 2 submits that the complaint of this petitioner has been forwarded by the learned Judicial Magistrate NO.I, Madurai, in Cr.MP No.4282 of 2024, dated 30.01.2025. They have conducted a preliminary enquiry, they found that the complaint of this petitioner has not made out any criminal offence and therefore they have filed a report before the learned Judicial Magistrate. A copy of the report is also placed before this Court.



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3. Recording the aforesaid submissions of the learned Government Advocate(Crl.side), this Criminal Original Petition is closed with a direction to the respondent police to furnish a copy of the closure report to the petitioner, enabling him to work out his remedy in the manner known to law.
