This case came up for settlement before the Lok Adalat. Both the parties present. The counsel for the appellant/s Mr.S.Michael Heldon Kumar and the counsel for the first respondent Mr.E.J.Daniel Robinson for Mr.A.Robinson, are present. After mutual discussion, negotiation, mediation and conciliation between both parties and with the assistance of the Bench, both sides consented for settlement.



AWARD



Both the parties and their respective counsels are present and they arrived at an amicable settlement for a sum of Rs.38,25,000/- [Rupees Thirty Eight Lakhs and Twenty Five Thousand only] as full quit. The first respondent is entitled to Rs.25,00,000/- [Rupees Twenty Five Lakhs only] and the second respondent is entitled to Rs.13,25,000/- [Rupees Thirteen Lakhs and Twenty Five Thousands only]. The second respondent appeared through virtual mode and agreed to for the above settlement.

2.It is submitted that already a sum of Rs.41,63,822/- [Rupees Forty One Lakhs Sixty Three Thousand Eight Hundred and Twenty Two only] with interest has been deposited before the Tribunal. The respondents/claimants are permitted to withdraw the amounts as agreed to above, on filing proper application before the Tribunal. The appellant is permitted to withdraw the balance amount, if any.
