PRAYER:Writ Petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying for the issuance of a Writ of Mandamus, directing the respondents to re-classify and issue patta in the name of the petitioner for the land in Survey No.



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317/3 extending to 2 acres and 23 cents at Ulagupitchanpatti, Thiruvathavur Village, Melur Taluk, Madurai District as “Wet Land” (Pujai) instead of “Tarisu Land”.

ORDER

This writ petition has been filed seeking a writ of mandamus to reclassify the land and issue patta in the name of the petitioner.

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“The petitioner made an application for reclassification of the subject land as early as on 14.10.2016 and consequently to issue patta in the petitioner's name. Admittedly the said application has not been disposed of as on date. In view of the same, the second respondent shall conduct an enquiry after affording an opportunity to the petitioner and pass orders in accordance with law and on merits within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.”

No costs. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petition is closed.
