2. Heard the arguments of Mr.B.Anandan, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner; Mr.D.S.Neduchezian, learned Government Advocate, who takes notice for the respondents 1 to 3 and Mr.M.Vaikkam Karunanithi, learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side), who takes notice for the fourth respondent.

3. By consent of both sides, this Writ Petition is taken up for final disposal at the admission stage itself.

4. According to the petitioner, the subject property was purchased by her and her husband Subramanian under registered sale deed, dated 10.12.2010. Now the petitioner's husband is no more. Hence, the patta for the subject property stands in the name of the petitioner and her children in Patta No.24862. The petitioner submitted an on-line application in application No.2025/0123/24/017325, on 03.07.2025 seeking survey of the subject property. The same has not been considered. Hence, the petitioner has come before this Court.
