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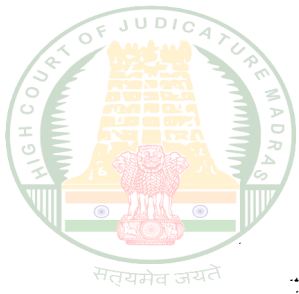
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ORDER

This petition has been filed to quash the impugned charge sheet filed for the offence under Section 323 & 506(ii) IPC and 3(1) of TNPPDL Act in S.C.No.105 of 2022 on the file of the learned Additional Sub Court, Pudukkottai.

2. The allegation in the final report is that due to land dispute, the petitioners entered into the premises of the defacto complainant, demolished the shed and other movable properties, threatened the defacto complainant and his family members and attacked him.

3. The petitioners and the second respondent have now entered into a compromise and decided to give a quietus to the entire dispute. The parties have filed a joint compromise memo dated 26th August, 2025 and the scanned copy of the compromise memo reads as follows:

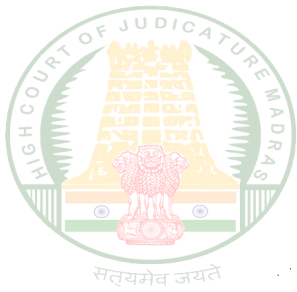

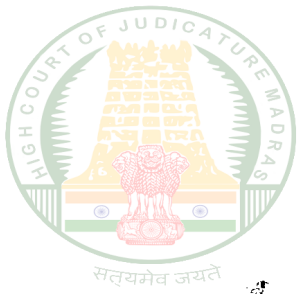
**JOINT COMPROMISE MEMO FILED BY THE PETITIONERS/

1. 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the Additional ~~Sub Court~~, Pudukkottai in S.C.No.105 of 2022 and the case is pending for trial.

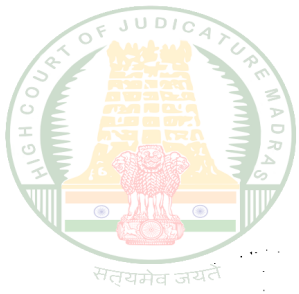
