PETITION FOR BAIL Under Sec.483 of BNSS

PRAYER :- For Bail in Crime No.209 of 2025 on the file of the Respondent Police.

ORDER : This Court made the following order :-

The petitioner / Accused, who was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 04.08.2025 for the offences punishable under Sections 20 and 25(1)(a) of Arms Act,

1959 in Crime No.209 of 2025 on the file of the respondent police, seeks bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that on 04.08.2025, this petitioner had threatened the public by using weapon thereby he created fear upon the minds of the people. Hence, the case.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that this petitioner is an innocent person and he has not committed any offences as alleged by the prosecution. This petitioner is ready and willing to abide any conditions that may be imposed by this Court. He would further submit that the petitioner is in custody from 04.08.2025, nearly 22 days. Hence, he seeks bail.

4. The learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side) would submit that this petitioner threatened the general public by showing weapon and created nuisance in the public place. In this case, weapon has been recovered from the accused person. At the time of occurrence, no one sustained any injury. This petitioner is having 12 previous case, out of which five cases disposed of and seven cases are pending against this petitioner. This petitioner has considered by the respondent police as organized crime accused. Hence, he objected to grant bail to the petitioner.

5. Taking into consideration of the facts and circumstances of the case and also taking note of the fact that in this case, weapon recovered by the respondent police, by this time material part of investigation might have been completed, the

petitioner/ Accused is in judicial custody from 04.08.2025, taking into consideration of

the period of incarceration, this court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner, subject
to the following conditions:

6. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on executing a bond for a sum of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand only) with two sureties, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of learned Judicial Magistrate No.1, Pudukottai and on further conditions that :-

[a] the sureties shall affix their photographs and Left Thumb Impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank pass Book to ensure their identity.

[b] The petitioner shall furnish his residential address and contact number to the learned Judicial Magistrate No.1, Pudukottai. If the petitioner changes his residential address, he shall report the same to the learned Judicial Magistrate No.1, Pudukottai;

[c] the petitioner shall report and sign before the respondent police daily twice at 10.00a.m. and 05.00p.m. Until further orders.

[d] the petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial.

[e] the petitioner shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial.

[f] On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560].

[g] If the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 269 BNS.
