This Criminal Revision Petition has been filed by the petitioner to set aside one of the condition imposed by the learned Principal District and Sessions Judge, Sivagangai in Cr.M.P.No.1899 of 2025 in Crl.A.No. 50 of 2025, dated 28.07.2025, that the Petitioner shall deposit 20% of the compensation awarded ie., Rs.8,00,000/- (Eight Lakh only) before the Trial Court within 30 days from the date of order.

3. When the matter was taken up for hearing, Mr.Muthumangaleshwar, learned counsel for Mr.K.Dinesh, learned



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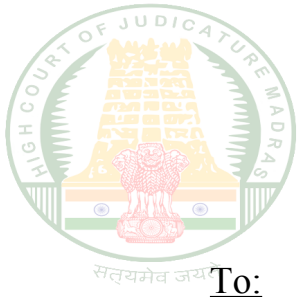
