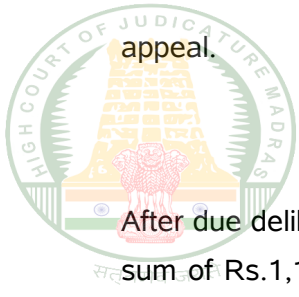

This case came up for settlement before the Lok Adalat. Both the parties present. The counsel for the appellant Mr. V. Sakthivel and the counsel for the respondents M/s. Sangararamasubramanian and K. Muthukumarasamy are present. After mutual discussion, negotiation, mediation and conciliation between both parties and with the assistance of the Bench, both sides consented for settlement.

AWARD

Aggrieved by the award passed by the Tribunal, the Appellant/Insurance Company has filed the present

appeal.

After due deliberations, both the parties have agreed into compromise and agreed to modify the amount to a sum of Rs.1,10,00,000/- (Rupees One Crore Ten Lakhs Only) towards full quit. The appellant has already deposited a sum of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand Only) before the Tribunal. The appellant is directed to deposit the remaining amount of Rs.1,09,75,000/- (Rupees One Crore Nine Lakhs and Seventy Five Thousand Only) within a period of Six weeks from the date of the Order. On such deposit being made, the claimants are entitled to withdraw the amount, equally, by filing formal application before the Tribunal.

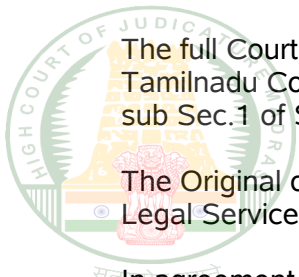
