ORDER

The learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side) appearing for the respondents no.1 and 2 would submit that they have not harassed the petitioner as alleged by him and there is a temple dispute in respect of conducting Festival for a particular period and already the said period was over. Therefore, nothing survives for further adjudication.

3. This Court heard both sides and also perused the records.

The representation of the petitioner is dated 27.09.2024, but the prayer is in respect of representation dated 01.10.2024 and there is no any such representation enclosed with this petition. However, the prayer of the petitioner is not to harass the petitioner and the respondent has also denied the alleged allegations. Therefore, recording the above said submissions of the learned Government Advocate, this criminal original petition is closed.
