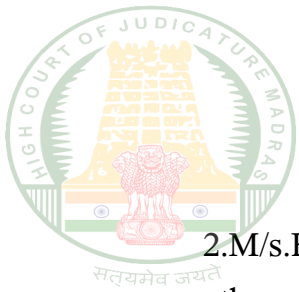

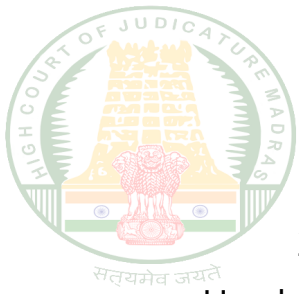

This case came up for settlement before the Lok Adalat. Both the parties present. The counsel for the appellant Mr.M.P.Senthil and the learned counsel for the second respondent M/s.K.R.Shivashankari are present. After mutual discussion, negotiation, mediation and conciliation between both parties and with the assistance of the Bench, both sides consented for settlement.

COMMON AWARD

Both the parties and their respective counsels are present and they arrive at an amicable settlement for a sum of Rs.5,00,000/- (Rupees Five Lakhs only) as full quit.



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2. It is submitted that Rs.70,671/- (Rupees Seventy Thousand Six Hundred and Seventy One) of the award amount has already been deposited before the Tribunal. The second respondent in the appeal / cross objector is directed to deposit the remaining amount, within a period of four [4] weeks from today. The appellants / claimants are permitted to withdraw the entire amount, less the amount if already withdrawn, on filing proper petition before the Tribunal.
