Petition filed under Section Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ of habeas corpus, directing the respondents to produce the body and person of the detainee by name Yamuna, wife of Jithin, aged 36 years before this Court and set her at liberty

ORDER

[Order of the Court was made by G.K.ILANTHIRAIYAN, J.,]

- (1) This writ petition has been filed by the husband of the detainee, Yamuna, aged 36 years, to cause production of his wife, who is said to be missing, before this Court and to set her at liberty.
- (2) Mr.R.M.Anbunithi, learned Additional Public Prosecutor accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.
- (3) The petitioner is the husband of the detainee. He got married with the detainee on 22.09.2007 and gave birth to a son. Earlier, the detainee used to leave the matrimonial home very often. So far, she had left the matrimonial home for more than five occasions and thereafter, the detainee returned to the matrimonial home. While so, on 16.07.2025, there was a quarrel between the spouses and as such, the detainee left the matrimonial home. Immediately, the petitioner lodged a complaint before the 3rd respondent police and the same has been registered in Crime No.



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473/2025 under "woman missing". During investigation, the 3rd

respondent found that the detainee left the matrimonial home due to misunderstanding between the petitioner and his wife, detainee herein.

The 3rd respondent also filed a Status Report before this Court.

(4) In view of the above facts and circumstances, the **3rd respondent police is directed to complete the investigation in Crime No.473/2025 and file the Final Report within a period of twelve weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.**

(5) The Habeas Corpus petition is **closed** with the above direction.
