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ORDER

WEB COPY This petition has been filed to quash the proceedings in D.V.C.No.5 of 2025 on the file of the Judicial Magistrate, Mudukulathur, Ramanathapuram District.

2. The facts of the case is that the first respondent got married to the first petitioner on 15.11.2021; that at the time of marriage, sufficient sridhana has been given to the first respondent by her parents; that a boy child was also born out of the wedlock; that from the date of marriage, there was a matrimonial difference between the first respondent and the first petitioner; that thereafter, at the instigation of other petitioners, who are in-laws of the first respondent, the first petitioner had committed cruelty upon the first respondent; that the first petitioner failed to maintain the respondents, who are his wife and son and thus committed the aforesaid offences.

3. When this case was taken up for hearing on 16.09.2025, this Court had referred the case to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre attached to this Bench. It appears from the mediation report, dated 22.09.2025, the parties have arrived at a settlement. The settlement agreement is extracted hereunder:



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SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

This SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT entered into on 22.09.2025 between

WHEREAS

1. Disputes and differences had arisen between the parties hereto and Crl.O.P(MD).No.14409 of 2025 was filed on 26.08.2025 before the Hon'ble Madurai Bench of Madras High Court.

2. The matter was referred to Mediation/Conciliation vide an order dated 16.09.2025 passed by Hon'ble Mr. Justice Sundar Mohan.

3. The parties agreed that Mr.S.Jeyasingh and Mrs. S.Bharathi would act as their Mediator/Conciliator.

4. Several meetings was held during the process of Mediation/Conciliation finally on 19.09.2025 to 22.09.2025 between parties, the parties have with the assistance of the Mediator/Conciliator voluntarily arrived at an amicable solution resolving the above mentioned disputes and differences.

5. The parties hereto confirm and declare that they have voluntarily and of their own free will arrived at this settlement agreement in the presence of the Mediator/Conciliator.

6. The Following settlement has been arrived at between the parties hereto

A. The 1st petitioner/husband shall take the Respondent No.1/wife and their son to an independent residence without affiliated with 1st petitioner's mother or relatives on or before 10th February 2026.

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B. The 1st petitioner shall maintain the 1st respondent in a dignified manner and the same should be reciprocated by 1st respondent also.

C. The 1st Petitioner shall pay Rs.5000/- (five thousand) per month to the respondents from October 2025 onwards. Payment shall be made on or before 10th day of every month.

D. The 1st respondent will retain her gold articles with her.

E. On the above conditions, the 1st respondent has agreed to withdraw P.I.R. in Crime No.104/2025 on the file of Mudukulathur Police Station Ramanad District and D.V.C.No.5/2025 on the file of Judicial Magistrate Mudukulathur, Ramanad District.

7. By signing this Agreement the parties hereto state that they have no further claims or demands against each other with respect to subject matter of Cr.O.P.(MD)No.14409 of 2025 and all disputes and differences in this regard have been amicably settled by the parties hereto through the process of conciliation/Mediation.
