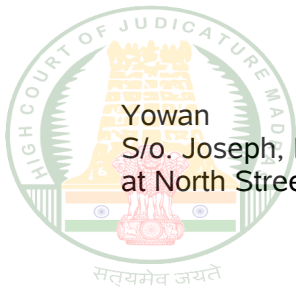

This case came up for settlement before the Lok Adalat. Both the parties present. The counsel for the appellant/s T.selvakumaran and the counsel for the respondent/s I.Sudhakaran are present. After mutual discussion, negotiation, mediation and conciliation between both parties and with the assistance of the Bench, both sides consented for settlement.

AWARD

Aggrieved by the Award passed by the Tribunal, the appellant / claimant has filed the present Appeal.

2. After due deliberations, both the parties have entered into compromise and agreed Rs.5,81,119/- (Rupees Five Lakhs Eighty one Thousand and one hundred nineteen only) with interest at the rate of 7.5% per annum from the date of filing of the claim petition till realization. The second respondent /Insurance Company is directed to deposit the entire award amount, after deducting the amount already deposited, if any, within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this Award, failing which the appellant shall pay the Award amount together with interest at the rate of 7.5% per annum. The claimant is permitted to withdraw the award amount by filing formal application before the Tribunal.
