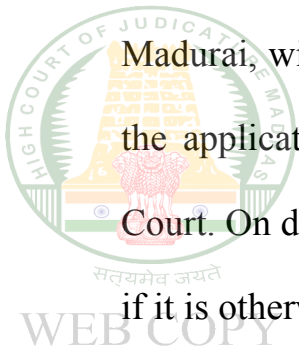
Prayer: To Condone the delay of 173 days in filing the appeal in CMA(MD) SR No. 73181 of 2025.
