Prayer: Criminal Original Petition is filed under Section 528 of BNSS, 2023, to direct the Special Court for Trial of Cases registered under SC/ST Act, Dindigul to consider the bail application filed by the Petitioners and pass appropriate orders in the bail application on the same date of their surrender related to the case in Crime No.306 of 2025 on the file of the respondent No.2.

ORDER

The petitioners seek a direction to the Special Court for Trial of Cases registered under SC/ST Act, Dindigul, to consider their bail application on the same day of surrender in Crime No.306 of 2025 on the file of the second respondent Police.

2. In view of the specific bar under Section 18 of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 and also taking into consideration of the facts of the case, there shall be a direction to the Special Court for Trial of Cases registered under SC/ST Act, Dindigul to consider the petitioners' bail application on the same day of their surrender in connection with Crime No.306 of 2025 registered for the offences under Section 296(b), 329(3), 351(2) of BNS, 2023 and Section 3(1)(r), 3(1)(s), 3(1)(c), 3(2)(va) of SC/ST (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989, and pass appropriate orders in accordance with law. It is needless to say that the Court below while disposing the bail petition shall consider the gravity of the offence, previous antecedent of the petitioners and pass orders, after affording due opportunity to the victim



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under Section 15-A of the SC/ST (POA) Act, 1989.

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3. The petitioners shall surrender before the concerned jurisdictional Court, within a period of fifteen (15) days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. The petitioners shall inform in advance the learned Public Prosecutor and the victim of the date of surrender and of the filing of the petition.

4. This Criminal Original Petition is ordered accordingly.
