PETITION FOR BAIL Under Sec.483 of BNSS

PRAYER :- For Bail in Cr.No.8 of 2025 on the file of the respondent police.



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ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioner, who was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 23.06.2025 for the offences punishable under Sections 5(1), 5(j)(ii) r/w 6(1) of Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Amendment Act, 2019, in Crime No.08 of 2025 on the file of the respondent police. seeks bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that at the time of occurrence, the victim has studied 12th standard. Further, the petitioner had entered to the house of the victim girl and sexual intercourse with the victim girl due to which, the victim girl is six months pregnant. Hence, the complaint.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is an innocent person and he has not committed any offences as alleged by the prosecution. He further submitted that the petitioner is ready and willing to abide by any conditions which may be imposed by this Court and he is in judicial custody from 23.06.2025. Hence, he seeks bail to the petitioner.

4. The learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side) submitted that the investigation has been completed and the charge sheet has also been filed in Spl.S,C.No.69 of 2025 before the Mahila Court, Pudukkottai. However, he opposed for grant of bail to the petitioner.



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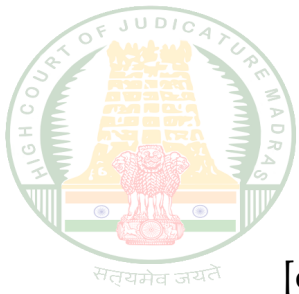
5. Taking into consideration of the facts and circumstances of the case and also the fact the investigation has been completed and the charge sheet has also been filed and the same was taken on file in Spl.S.C.No.69 of 2025 on the file of the Mahila Court, Pudukkottai and also consideration the period of incarceration suffered by the petitioner, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner, subject to the following conditions:

6. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate, Thirumayam, and on further conditions that :-

[a] the sureties shall affix their photographs and Left Thumb Impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank pass Book to ensure their identity.

[b] the petitioner shall appear before the trial Court daily at 10.30 a.m., until further orders.

[c] the petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial.



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[d] the petitioner shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial.

[e] On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560].

[f] If the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 269 BNS.
