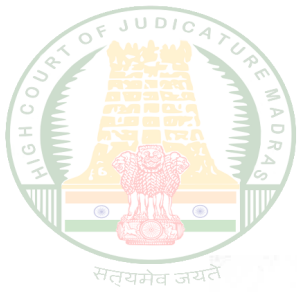
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ORDER

The petitioners seek to quash the final report in FR.No.42 of 2024 dated 18.07.2024 on the file of the learned District Munsif cum Judicial Magistrate, Thirupuvanam, which was filed for the offences under Section 341, 294(b), 324 and 506(2) IPC.

2. The allegation in the final report is that due to prior enmity, the petitioners abused the defacto complainant in filthy language, attacked him and threatened him with dire consequences and thus, committed the aforesaid offences.

3. Admittedly, the petitioners and the second respondent belong to the same village and they have now entered into a compromise and decided to give a quietus to the entire dispute. The parties have filed a joint compromise memo dated 15th September 2025 and the scanned copy of the compromise memo reads as follows:

I, Nagaraj, son of Ramar, Hindu aged about 28 years, having residence at Vayalcheri Village, Sivanankulam, Thirupuvanam Taluk, Sivagangai Distric, the 2nd respondent/defacto complainant herein, do hereby solemnly affirm and sincerely states as follows:

1. We, hereby jointly filed the present criminal original petition seeking to call for the records of pending final report in FR.No.42 of 2024 dated 18.07.2024 on the file of Learned District Munsif cum Judicial Magistrate, Thirupuvanam Court for the offence under sections 341, 294(b), 324 and 506(ii) of IPC in Crime No. 7 of 2024 dated 01.02.2024 on the file of the 1st respondent police and quash the same as of now that the de-facto complainant and the petitioners herein met together with friends and elders of the Villages to settle the issue amicably.

2. We, hereby jointly file this compromise affidavit at the stage of final report by the respondent police before the trial court which is not taken on file in the meantime that the petitioners and de-facto complainant who were said to be freinds were met together and entered compromise between us and begin the good relations with each other.

3. We both the petitioners and the 2nd respondent belongs to the friends of the same Village, later after registration of FIR both known to each other and immediately arrived for compromise between from the outside of the court, hence the pending FIR creates gap between the relationship of petitioners and hence with the consent of the 2nd respondent herein present petition was filed.

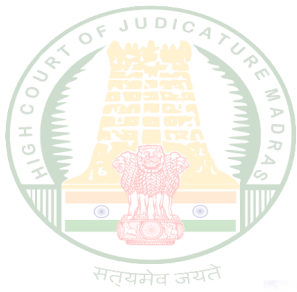
4. We, hereby respectfully states that the entire cases of the prosecutions arise out of the misunderstanding of the words

5. We, hereby respectfully states that in order to maintain peace and harmony in the friendly relationship residing in the same locality we agreed for this compromise petition and hence the present averments in the FIR have to be quashed and with great respect states that the pendency of the present criminal case breaks the harmony and peacefulness of the present relationship between each other.

6. We, hereby with great respect submit that we both with the instance of our elder family members entered into compromise as no purpose is going to be served in conducting the present criminal case, wherein, in turn it will spoil the carrier of the petitioners; hence we file this present petition.

7. We, hereby submit that with our full consciousness, without any coercion or compulsion, enter into the present compromise memo, by which, the defacto complainant who is none other than the known persons of the same Village, hereby withdraws the entire allegation as posed upon the petitioner herein in the said Criminal Case and as such, the 2nd respondent render his concurrence to quash the entire criminal case to reach the Ends of Justice. It is also decided between us that on quashing the final report, there will be no continuation of any proceeding between the entire parties in future.

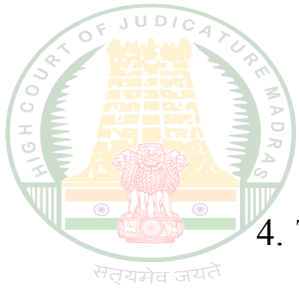

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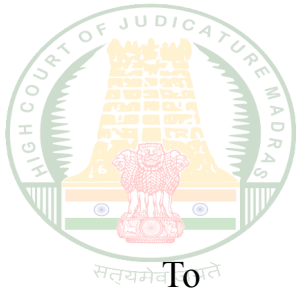
4. 5. In view of the same and considering the nature of the offences and the relationship between the parties, this Court is of the view that no useful purpose would be served by keeping the impugned final report pending trial. Accordingly, the impugned final report in FR.No.42 of 2024 dated 18.07.2024 is quashed and the Criminal Original Petition stands allowed.
