PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.482 of BNSS

PRAYER :-

For Anticipatory Bail in Cr.No.165 of 2025 on the file of the respondent police.



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ORDER: The Court made the following order :-

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The petitioner/ accused, who apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 331(4) and 305 of BNS in Crime No.165 of 2025, on the file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that the petitioner along with other accused said to have stolen the spare parts of the windmill worth about Rs.64,000/-. Hence the case.

3.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case and he has not committed any offence. He would further submit that based on the confession statement the petitioner herein was implicated as an accused. He seeks this Court to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

4.The learned Government Advocate(Crl.Side) appearing for the respondent submitted that investigation in this pending and the property not yet recovered, thereby he would oppose to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

5.Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and also the fact that no previous case is pending against the petitioner , this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner with certain conditions.

6.Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of



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arrest or on his appearance, on condition that the petitioner shall execute a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate Aundipatti within a period of fifteen days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order and on further conditions that:

[a]the petitioner and the sureties shall affix their photographs and left thumb impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhaar card or bank pass book to ensure their identity;

[b]the petitioner shall report before the respondent police daily at 6.30 p.m., until further orders.

[c]the petitioner shall not tamper with the evidence or witness either during investigation or trial.

[d]the petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial.

[e]On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner is released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560].



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[f]If the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section

269 of BNS.
