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ORDER

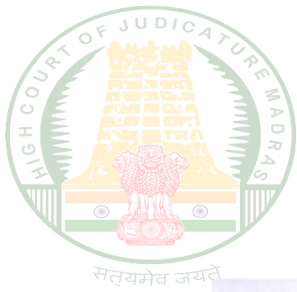
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The petitioner seeks for quashing of the FIR in Crime No. 586 of 2024 on the file of the first respondent police, for the alleged offences under Sections 296(b), 229(2), 351(3), 318(2), 336(2) and Sections 3 & 4 of TN Prohibition of Charging Exorbitant Interest Act, 2003.

2. The allegation against the petitioner is that due to money dispute, the petitioner had abused the defacto complainant in filthy language and attacked him and also threatened him with dire consequences.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned counsel for the defacto complainant/the second respondent would submit that the parties have now entered into a compromise on the advise of the elders and well-wishers and both the parties have agreed that the impugned F.I.R may be quashed.

4. The parties have also filed a joint compromise memo dated 8th September 2025. The scanned copy of the compromise memo reads as follows:

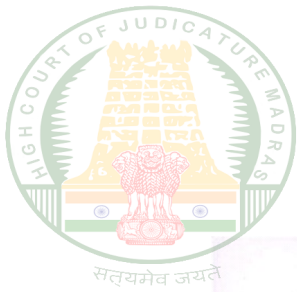
JOINT COMPROMISE MEMO FILED BY BOTH THE PARTIES

1. It is submitted that, the petitioner is sole accused in the above Criminal case in Crime No. 586 of 2024 for the offences under sections 296(b), 229(2), 351(3), 318(2), 336(2) and Sections 3 & 4 of TN prohibition of Charging exorbitant interest Act 2003.

2. It is pertinent to mention that, the petitioner/Accused and the defacto complainant are residing same locality and both are known to each other very well and friends also. It is further submitted that, due to the money dispute between them the present case was filed against the petitioner due to flimsy grounds.

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3. It is submitted that, during the pendency of the above criminal case, the well wishers of both the family elders and the well wishers of the friends are advised the both the parties in the interest of peace of our personal life and accordingly both parties have compromised themselves between them. Hence, it is just and necessary to file this compromise memo before this Hon'ble Court and record the same and dispose of the above CrI.O.P. Hence the above may kindly be recorded.

It is therefore prayed that this Hon'ble Court may be pleased to record the above compromise arrived between the petitioners and the defacto complainant are concerned amicably and prays this Hon'ble Court to quash the FIR in Crime No. 586 of 2024 on the file of the respondent police and allow the Criminal original petition and pass such other orders as this Hon'ble Court may deem fit and proper in the circumstances of the case and thus render justice.

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5. The petitioner and the second respondent are present before this Court in person. They are identified by Mr.S.Pargunan, S.S.I., E.Pudur Police Station. Both the parties confirmed the compromise arrived at between them.

Considering the fact that the F.I.R discloses predominantly a money dispute and the parties have arrived at a compromise, this Court is of the view that no useful purpose would be served by keeping the impugned FIR pending investigation. Accordingly, the impugned FIR in Crime No. 586 of 2024 on the file of the first respondent police, is hereby quashed and the Criminal Original Petition stands allowed.
