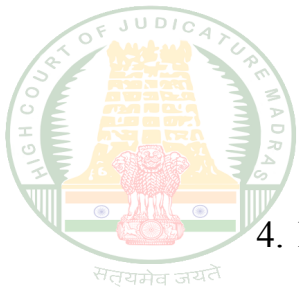

ORDER

The petitioners seek for a direction to the learned Additional District and Sessions Judge (Special Court for PCR Cases), Dindigul to consider their bail application on the same day of their surrender in respect of Crime No.151 of 2025 on the file of the 2nd respondent, pending investigation.

2. The learned counsel for the petitioners would submit that the injured has been discharged from the hospital.

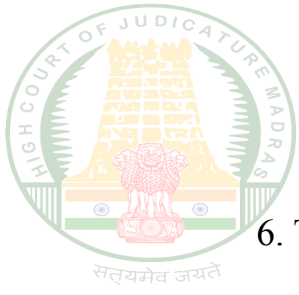
3. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor confirms the aforesaid fact.



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4. In view of the specific bar under Section 18 of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 and also taking into consideration of the facts of the case, there shall be a direction to the learned Additional District and Sessions Judge (Special Court for PCR Cases), Dindigul to consider the petitioners' bail application on the same day of their surrender in connection with Crime No.151 of 2025 registered for the offences under Section 191(2), 137(2) of BNS, 2023, Section 3(1) of Tamil Nadu Public Property (Prevention of Damage and Loss) Act, 1992 and Section 3(2)(va) of SC/ST (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 and pass appropriate orders in accordance with law. It is needless to say that the Court below while disposing the bail petition shall consider the gravity of the offence, previous antecedent of the petitioners and pass orders, after affording due opportunity to the victim under Section 15-A of the SC/ST (POA) Act, 1989.

5. The petitioners shall surrender before the concerned jurisdictional Court, within a period of fifteen (15) days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. The petitioners shall inform in advance the learned Public Prosecutor and the victim of the date of surrender and of the filing of the petition.



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6. This Criminal Original Petition is ordered accordingly.
