ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioner, who was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 04.08.2025 for the offences punishable under Sections 77, 351(3) of BNS and Section 4 of TNPHW Act, 67, 67(A) of IT Act, in Crime No. 191 of 2025 on the file of the respondent police, seeks bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that the defacto complainant is a lady separated from her husband, both the petitioner and the complainant have relationship and the petitioner took photographs and videos while they were co-inhabited. Thereafter since the wife of the complainant returned compromised and she is living with her husband, she stopped the relationship with the petitioner. So on 29.06.2025 the petitioner sent the obscene photographs and videos of them to the husband and other relatives of the complainant and threatened her to live with him, unless he would share the video in the social media. Hence, the complaint.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is an innocent person and he has not committed any offences as alleged by the prosecution. He further submitted that the petitioner is



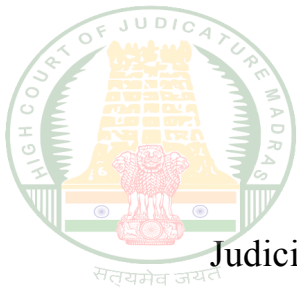

ready and willing to abide by any conditions which may be imposed by this Court and he is in judicial custody from 04.08.2025. Hence, he seeks bail to the petitioner.

4. The learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side) submitted that the petitioner had uploaded the obscene photographs and videos and the same were deleted. He further submitted that there is no previous case pending against the petitioner and the investigation has been completed. However, he opposed for grant of bail to the petitioner.

5. Taking into consideration of the facts and circumstances of the case and also the fact that the investigation has been completed and also consideration the period of incarceration suffered by the petitioner, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner, subject to the following conditions:

6. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned

Judicial Magistrate No.5, Tirunelveli, and on further conditions that :-

WEB COPY

[a] the sureties shall affix their photographs and Left Thumb Impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank pass Book to ensure their identity.

[b] the petitioner shall report before the respondent police daily at 10.30 a.m., until further orders.

[c] the petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial.

[d] the petitioner shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial.

[e] On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560].
