PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.482 of BNSS

PRAYER :- For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.189 of 2025 on the file
of the respondent police



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ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioner/Accused, who apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 296(b), 351(2) and 318(4) of BNS Act 2023, in Crime No.189 of 2025 on the file of the respondent police. seeks anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that the Petitioner had received a sum of Rs.11 Lakhs from the defacto complainant for the purpose of arranging loan. Thereafter, the petitioner had issued two cheques value of the amount of Rs.25 Lakhs to the defacto complainant and the same was dishonoured. Further, the petitioner had threatened the defacto complainant. Hence, the complaint.

3.The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is an innocent and she has been falsely implicated in this case. He further submitted that the petitioner had deposited a sum of Rs.1 Lakh to the credit of Crime numnber to show his bonafide and the reciept also been produced before this Court. He further submitted that the petitioner is ready and willing to abide by any stringent conditions that may be



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imposed by this Court. Hence, he seeks anticipatory bail.

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4.The learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) Submitted that there is no previous case pending against the petitioner. However, he opposed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

5. Taking into consideration of the facts and circumstances of the case and since the petitioner has complied with the conditions imposed by this Court dated 11.09.2025 and there is no previous case pending against the petitioner, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner, with certain conditions.:

6. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance, on condition that the petitioner shall execute a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the Judicial Magistrate Court No.II, Nagercoil, Kanyakumari District, within a period of fifteen days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order and on further conditions that:



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[a]the petitioner and the sureties shall affix their photographs and left thumb impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhaar card or bank pass book to ensure their identity;

[b] the petitioner shall report before the respondent police daily at 10.30 a.m., for a period of three weeks and thereafter, as and when required for interrogation.

[c]the petitioner shall not tamper with the evidence or witness either during investigation or trial.

[d]the petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial.

[e]On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner is released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560].



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[f] If the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 269 of BNS.

7. In the result, this Criminal Original Petition is allowed. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petition is closed.
