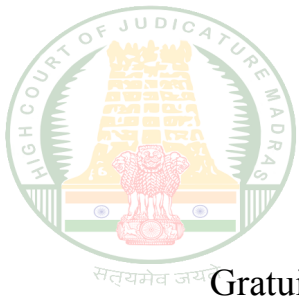

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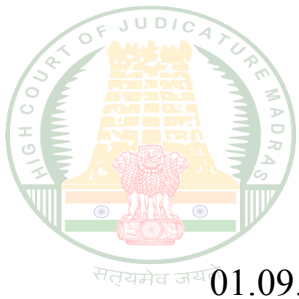

2.Considering the admitted fact that there has been a delay in payment and based on the representation of the petitioner, dated



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01.09.2025, the respondents are directed to disburse the interest amount as per the relevant statutory provisions, within a period of twelve weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.
